

God's Courtroom provides unique evangelistic option

SHERMAN, III. – A new hour-long documentary looks at the result of sin from God's perspective.

"Your trial will be public," says Bruce Kugler, an attorney for 22 years and a member for 10 years of the leadership team at Living Faith Baptist Church in Sherman, Ill.

Kugler uses scripture to back up each point he makes in *God's Courtroom*, a professionally-produced film available free on the website www.GodsCourtroom.org. It also will be viewed at 9 p.m. Eastern time June 25 on the NRB television network – DirecTV 378 and Sky Angel 126.

"God has been videotaping your entire life," Kugler narrates in the film, referring in an attorney's "just the facts" voice to Matthew 12:36 to make his point. [Jesus says,] "I tell you that on the day of judgment people will have to account for every careless word they speak."

God's Courtroom powerfully describes the charge, potential defenses, penalty, witnesses,

burden of proof, and most importantly, God's offer of a pardon to every person.

Set in the heart of the Land of Lincoln, drawing on President Abraham Lincoln's historic legal career, this documentary was filmed in four historic (and magnificent) Illinois courthouses, plus the Old State Capitol of Illinois, and a cell in the Old Franklin County Jail.

At one point Kugler stands inside one of the jail cells as he speaks. The cell bars then shut with a throat-grabbing metallic thud that makes the point: No one can reverse God's decision, he says, referencing Isaiah 43:13.

"Bruce has utilized his legal and biblical knowledge to prepare this message in splendid fashion," said William Weedman, retired associate executive director for the Illinois Baptist State Association. "You will be impressed by the quality of his message."

God's Courtroom closes with an invitation to accept a plea agreement, a pardon, possible because of Jesus.
